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UKCA MARKING POST 1 JANUARY 2022

BREXIT - IMPACT

Deviation in Regulation means that from 1 January 2022 certain products being placed on the GB market will need a **UKCA (UK Conformity Assessed)** marking.

SELLING GOODS IN G.B

- The UKCA marking mainly applies to goods that were subjected to the CE marking prior to Brexit.
- The **UKCA** marking is **not recognised** within the EU market.
- Once the businesses demonstrates conformity, the manufacturer or an authorised representative must retain the relevant documentation for 10 years as proof that the product conforms with regulatory requirements.

WHEN TO USE THE UKCA MARK

- When the product is being **sold** within the **GB market** (Excluding Northern Ireland).
- When the product is covered by **legislation** which required a **UKCA mar**k.
- When the product requires a third-party conformity assessment.
- When the product's conformity assessment has been successfully carried out by a GB Conformity Assessment Body.

WHEN PLACING THE UKCA MARKING

- The marking must be at least **5 mm in height** for the whole logo,
- The UKCA marking must be **clearly visible and legible t**o the product itself or the packaging.

NORTHERN IRELAND

Northern Ireland continues to align within EU regulations, which means **products sold within Northern Ireland must still meet EU requirements.** What businesses need to do depends on the variety of good being sold within the market and whether it requires a CE or a CE UK(NI) mark. UK DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

This is a document that **must be drawn up for any product using the UKCA marking**. It is recommended that manufacturers have both a UK and EU Declaration of Conformity. The UK Declaration of Conformity should be available to market surveillance authorities on request.
